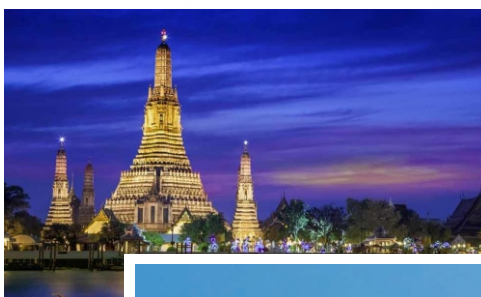

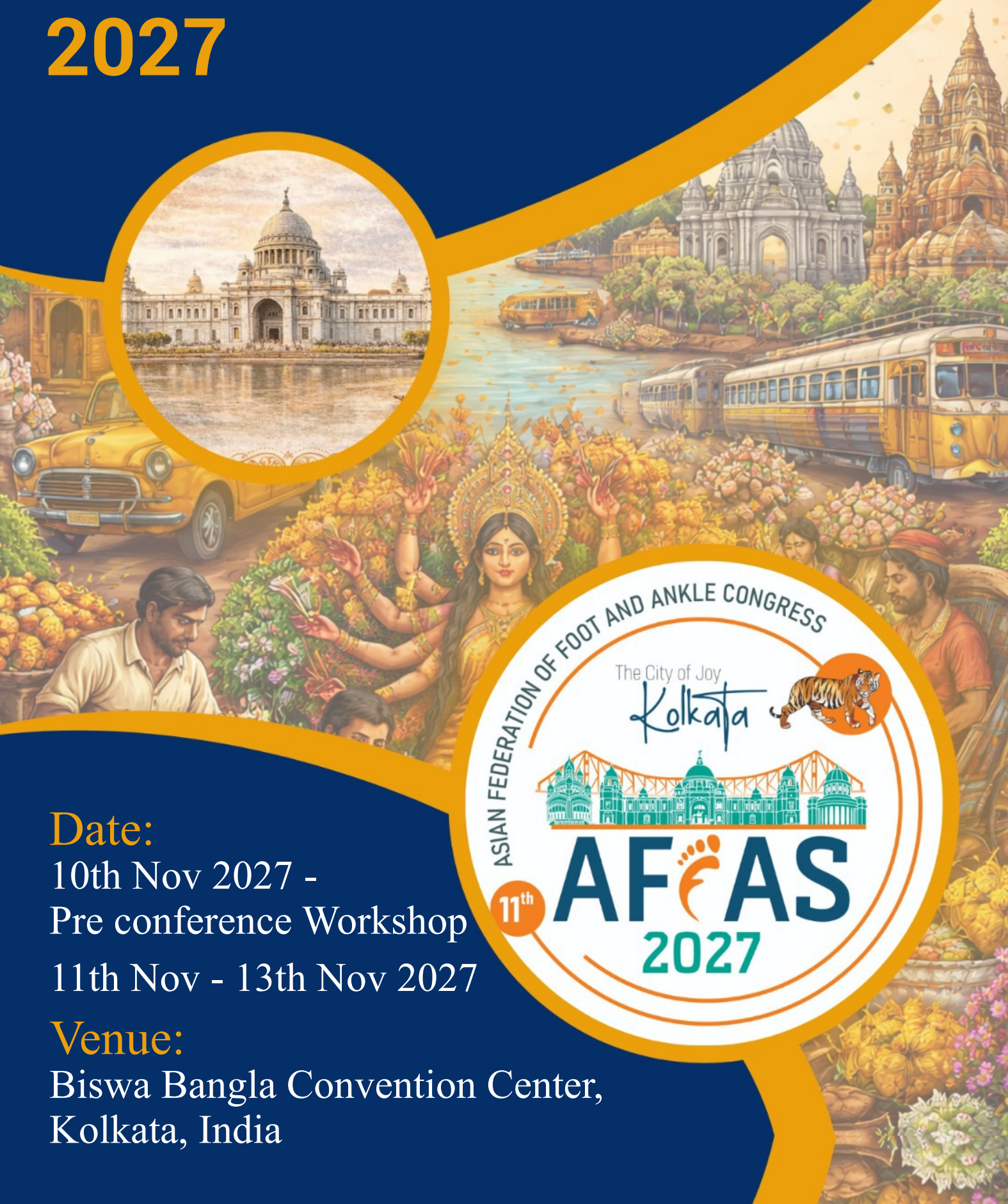

The 10th Annual Meeting of the [Asian Federation of Foot and Ankle Surgeons](#) (AFFAS) took place from 30 October to 1 November 2025 at the Grand Copthorne Waterfront Hotel, Singapore. This landmark meeting, chaired by Dr Chong Keen Wai, brought together leading foot and ankle surgeons, researchers, and allied health professionals from across Asia and beyond. Jointly organised by the Asian Federation of Foot & Ankle Surgeons (AFFAS) and the Singapore Orthopaedic Association (SOA), the meeting served

Pre-Congress Courses

This year's programme featured a comprehensive scientific agenda covering the full spectrum of foot and ankle practice. Key highlights included updates on minimally invasive surgery, complex deformity correction, sports injuries, diabetic foot management, Charcot

arthropathy, and advances in biologics and orthobiologics. International and regional faculty delivered thought-provoking lectures, while interactive case discussions and panel debates stimulated dynamic engagement among participants.

The free paper and poster presentations showcased high-quality research from emerging and established centres across Asia. Young surgeons and trainees actively contributed, reflecting the strong growth and future potential of foot and ankle subspecialisation in the region.

The AFFAS-SOA Meeting 2025 reaffirmed Singapore's position as a key regional hub for

AFFAS Research Spotlight:

A Milestone in Regional Orthopaedics
The New IFAS Score: Pioneering the First Patient-Reported Outcome Measure for the Asian Population

Dear Members of the Asian Federation of Foot and Ankle Surgeons, We are excited to highlight a groundbreaking publication recently featured in the Indian Journal of Orthopaedics. For years, orthopaedic surgeons across Asia have relied on Patient-Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs) that, while clinically validated, often lack cultural relevance for our local populations. Western scoring systems frequently do not account for regional functional necessities—such as squatting, sitting cross-legged, or walking barefoot. Addressing this critical gap, members of the Indian foot and ankle society have developed the Indian Foot and Ankle Society (IFAS) Score.

Crucially, this marks a monumental step forward for our region: the IFAS Score is the very first PROM specifically designed and validated for an Asian population. This tool is tailored to evaluate foot and ankle disorders by directly addressing the unique cultural and functional demands of patients in our demographic.

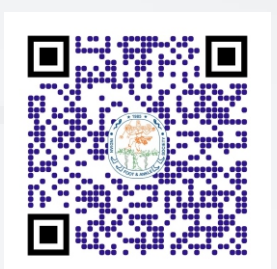

Key Highlights

- A Regional First: Represents the first culturally relevant PROM score developed specifically for the Asian population, setting a new standard for localized orthopaedic research.
- Targeted Background: Developed in response to the explicit lack of cultural relevance in existing PROMs for foot and ankle disorders.
- Enhanced Patient Care: Allows surgeons to evaluate outcomes based on the actual day-to-day functional needs and cultural habits of their patients, leading to more accurate post-operative assessments.

IFAS is delighted to announce the global expansion of the score, which is now available in all Asian languages – Mandarin, Korean, Japanese, Thai, Malay, Cantonese, English and all Indian languages.


